Entries will be on display at the Lewistown Art Center from January 24 through February 26 during Art Center hours: Tuesday – Friday 10:00 am – 5:00 pm and Saturday 10:00 am – 4:00 pm.

Registration: Deadline January 15, 2019

Pick Up:

Items may be picked up at the Lewistown Art Center between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm Wednesday, February 28 or regular Art Center hours the rest of that week. If you would like your exhibit returned to you by mail (at your own risk), please include the cost of shipping with your entry form.

Prizes:

First place gifts will be awarded in every class.

One overall Best of Show will be awarded.

Sale of Items:

If any individual would like to sell items, a booth space must be rented through Montana Winter Fair Trade Show, your booth will be in the Trade Center at the Fergus County Fairgrounds.

RULES:

1. All entered items must have been created within the past twelve months.
2. Any item that has been knitted, crocheted, woven, needle felted, or hand spun will be accepted for entry.
3. The item entered must have been created by entrant.
4. Items will be judged and then displayed for the remainder of the fair.
5. Items for exhibit cannot be sold during the display period.

Class 1 – Large Wearable Items (sweaters, vests, etc.)

Lot 1 – Knitted, Crocheted

- Lot 2 – Hand Woven
- Lot 3 – Tatted, Needle Point, Embroidery, etc.
- Lot 4 – Felting
- Lot 5 – Refurbished

Class 2 – Small Wearable Items (mittens, hats, scarves, etc.)

- Lot 1 – Knitted, Crocheted
- Lot 2 – Hand Woven
- Lot 3 – Tatted, Needle Point, Embroidery, etc.
- Lot 4 – Felting
- Lot 5 – Refurbished

Class 3 – Large Non–Wearable Items (table cloth, afghan, coverlets, tapestries, saddle blankets etc.)

- Lot 1 – Knitted, Crocheted
- Lot 2 – Hand Woven
- Lot 3 – Tatted, Needle Point, Embroidery, etc.
- Lot 4 – Felting
- Lot 5 – Refurbished

Class 4 – Small Non– Wearable Items (place mats, toys, halters, leashes etc.)

Class 6 – Preteen, 12 and under years of age, Any Item

- Lot 1 – Knitted, Crocheted
- Lot 2 – Hand Woven
- Lot 3 – Latch Hook
- Lot 4 – Hooked
- Lot 5 – Braided

Class 7 – Teen, 13 to 18 years of age, Any Item

- Lot 1 – Knitted, Crocheted
- Lot 2 – Hand Woven
- Lot 3 – Tatted, Needle Point, Embroidery, etc.
- Lot 4 – Felting
- Lot 5 – Refurbished

Class 8 – Hand Spun Yarn – Skeins need to be 2–4 oz. in weight (Skeins must be washed)

- Lot 1 – Woolen– any fiber
- Lot 2 – Worsted– any fiber
- Lot 3 – Novelty– any fiber or blended
- Lot 4 – Exotic– Camel, Yak, Buffalo, etc.
